

JSA/JHA Training

Course Overview

The aim of this training course is to enable participants who are involved in applying basic risk control processes to efficiently and effectively perform a Job Safety Analysis (JSA) on any task in any workplace.

This hands-on workshop involves identifying hazards, assessing risk, identifying unacceptable risk, developing effective controls and recording the JSA.



Assessment of underpinning knowledge will be by way of oral questioning and group work.

Participants will be required to demonstrate through practical scenario simulating the completion of a Job Safety Analysis Form. Participants will receive a Certificate of Attendance.
