Overview

The course meets the essential requirements for safety inductions within the Mines Safety and Inspection Act and Regulations 1995.

All elements of general mine safety are included in the course including; following site safety procedures and applying personal safety measures. Participants are also taken through incident reporting and applying emergency procedures, as well as different aspects of maintaining personal well being.

The MARCSTA certification is valid for two years after which participants can undertake a half-day refresher course to maintain their certification.
