

# Mining Specific OSH

## Course Overview

It is essential that team leaders are able to provide OSH information to their workgroup under the relevant Mines and Regulations Act. An understanding of risk management and the duty of care requirements is an essential aspect in the provision of a safe workplace environment.

Optional: Participants can apply to be assessed against the Unit of Competency BSBOHS407A Monitor a Safe Workplace.

*Note: Competency assessment is an additional \$120.00 per person (GST free) and participants have 6 weeks to submit the assignment.*

Upon successful completion a Statement of Attainment will be awarded.
