The Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) course is required in Western Australia for anyone who serves, supplies or sells alcohol.

This three hour course meets all requirements of the relevant state Liquor Act and may be required for the following job roles:

- Bar staff
- Nightclub staff
- Bottle shop staff
- Crowd controllers
- Service staff at licensed functions
- Flight Attendants
- Waiters
- Concierges
- Wine tasting staff



Upon successful completion, you will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for SITHFAB009A Provide Responsible Service of Alcohol.
