

Rio Tinto Health Safety & Environment Induction

Prior to entering any Rio Tinto Iron Ore (RTIO) site, personnel are required to attend an induction. The level of induction will be dependent on the scope of work and associated risks. The Rio Tinto HSE Induction applies to all personnel entering site except visitors and some short-term contractors.

The objective of the Rio Tinto HSE is to provide participants with the knowledge to work safely and responsibly in accordance with legislative requirements and the Rio Tinto Iron Ore Health, Safety and Environmental work standards

In addition to the Rio Tinto HSE Induction, personnel are also required to complete the Rio Tinto General Site Induction (GSI). AVELING run the GSI at the completion of the Rio Tinto HSE Induction and it is included in the prices listed below.
