ARE YOUR PEOPLE EQUIPPED TO ASSESS RISK?

Overview

This course covers the skills and knowledge required to implement and apply risk management processes with an established system. It includes the application of local hazard identification, formal risk assessment and implementation of risk controls. Also covered is the monitoring of the system, reporting on implementation issues, communication of processes and systems, and the review and auditing of risk management.

Content

- Determine the risk management process
- Identify hazards
- Assess risk
- Identify unacceptable risk
- Identify potential actions
- Decide on action
- Implement or facilitate action
- Review the implementation of action
- Audit the risk management process
- Complete records and reports

- Case studies
