

# BSB30707 Certificate III in Occupational Health and Safety

## Overview

The qualification consists of five days face-to-face training, underpinning knowledge questions, third party reports and workplace assignments.

## Intended for

This qualification is for those who perform OHS tasks as part of their role such as Safety and Health representatives (SHRS) and those interested in an entry point into an OHS career.

## Qualification Structure

The qualification is delivered over five days and comprises 12 Units of Competency. Participants must complete all Units of Competency to gain the qualification.
